In remembering the tragic events of the Newcastle earthquake 30 years ago, the organizing committee would like to focus on what has changed in the intervening years and if, as a community, we are really any better prepared for the next event. In considering this, authors are invited to submit papers which address:

- Adequacy of current design standards;
- Compliance with current standards (from both a design and a construction perspective);
- The role of seismology in developing building codes for areas of low seismicity;
- Disaster planning, response, recovery and resilience studies;
- The performance of non-structural parts and components;
- Structural monitoring;
- Seismic retrofit of existing structures;
- The performance of lifelines, large-loss facilities and critical infrastructure including power distribution systems and dams;
- Mining.

The committee will also welcome papers on general earthquake engineering and engineering seismology.

Please send an abstract of not more than 200 words by **30 June 2019**. Upon receipt and review of abstract, authors will receive further instructions on acceptance of their abstract and instructions for writing full papers. Accepted papers will be peer reviewed and published in the conference proceedings, and later on the AEES website.
